Bob Roden Quintet to perform jazz classics at The Spotlight

Berkeley-based jazz group The Bob Roden Quintet will perform at The Spotlight in the Fireside Room on Wednesday, March 13, from noon to 1 p.m.

The show will feature classic tunes spanning the great eras of jazz, from Benny Goodman through Frank Sinatra and beyond. Songs will include "The Days of Wine and Roses," "Exactly Like You," "Autumn Leaves" and many other favorites.

Led by trombonist/vocalist Bob Roden, the quintet – which also includes sax, piano, upright bass and drums – is renowned for its engaging performances. Now in its seventh year, the group has twice played featured slots at the Piedmont Jazz Festival, and this month will make its third
